1.3.1 Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to Professional Ethics ,Gender, Human Values ,Environment and Sustainability into the Curriculum

Response:

The curriculum consists of all the relevant cross cutting issues such as Social Concerns, Professional Ethics, Gender Equality, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability. Professional ethics courses such as Business Administration, Teacher Education and Sports ethics; Social responsibilities and corporate governance; Gender equality as in Gender School and Society in B.Ed. Course are taught in the different streams as per the specific subjects. Below mentioned are some references where these particular values are taught –

Environmental studies focus on significance of environmental protection, maintenance and sustainable development.

Personality development and leadership qualities are inculcated through various activities such as National/International days on various issues like International Day of Yoga and World Environment day. Students are trained and encouraged to take part in cultural and sports activities. Also to make them sensitized about the general and specific health hazards, Worlds AIDS Day are organized. Large number of students as well as teaching/non-teaching faculty participate in one or all of the above activities.

Special inputs through various Committees-

- Women Counseling Cell The Women Counseling Cell organizes seminars to focus on gender related issues and personal hygiene. It organizes various training program like self-defense, do's and dont's and life style issues.
- **Internal complaint committee** -Institute has internal complaint committee to resolve complaints related to sexual harassment of any individual within the campus. It also organizes different types of activity to promote mutual understanding and respect among the students.

In addition to the above -

- The Institute also has a medicinal garden maintained with the help of students where knowledge ofeasily available medicinal plants for cheap medical aid is imparted.
- There is a system of water harvesting through three ponds created by the institute which keep the tubwells recharged throughout the year.
- A large amount of liquid and Solid waste is accumulated in the safety tanks and waste water tanks which is recycled to water the lawns, flower beds and manuring of the same.
- There are large number of computer/electronic and electrical labs in the campus which generateample amount of e-waste which is destroyed or sold of as per the specified protocol.
