

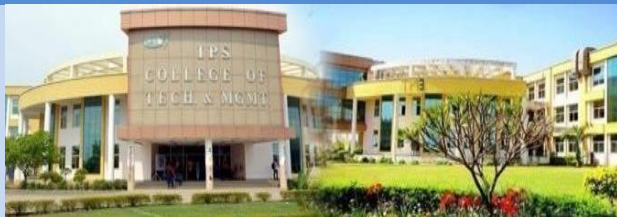
ABOUT THE AICTE
